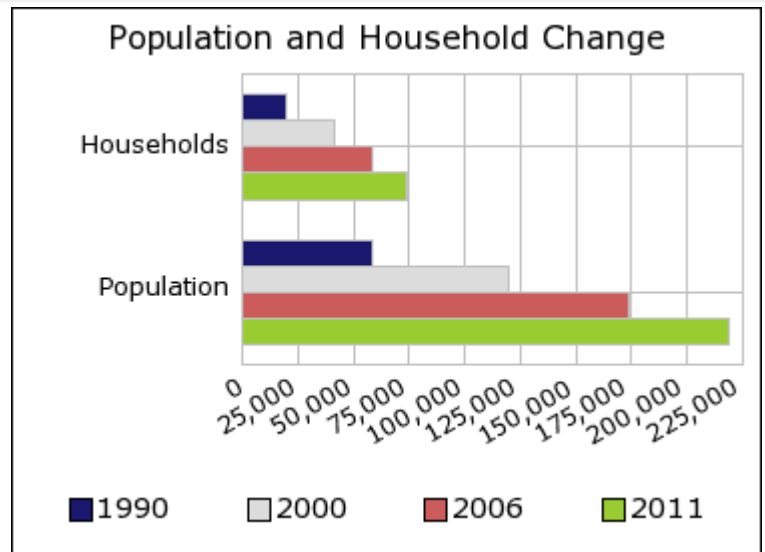

Population Demographics:

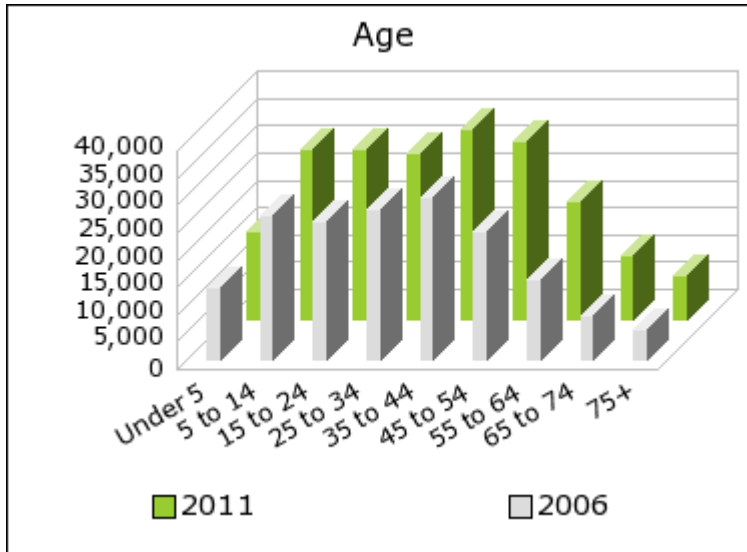
The number of households in the study area in 1990 was **20,011** and changed to **41,373** in 2000, representing a change of **106.8%**. The household count in 2006 was **58,592** and the household projection for 2011 is **73,603**, a change of **25.6%**.

The population in the study area in 1990 was **58,738** and in 2000 it was **119,341**, roughly a **103.2%** change. The population in 2006 was **173,807** and the projection for 2011 is **219,048** representing a change of **26.0%**.

Population by Age

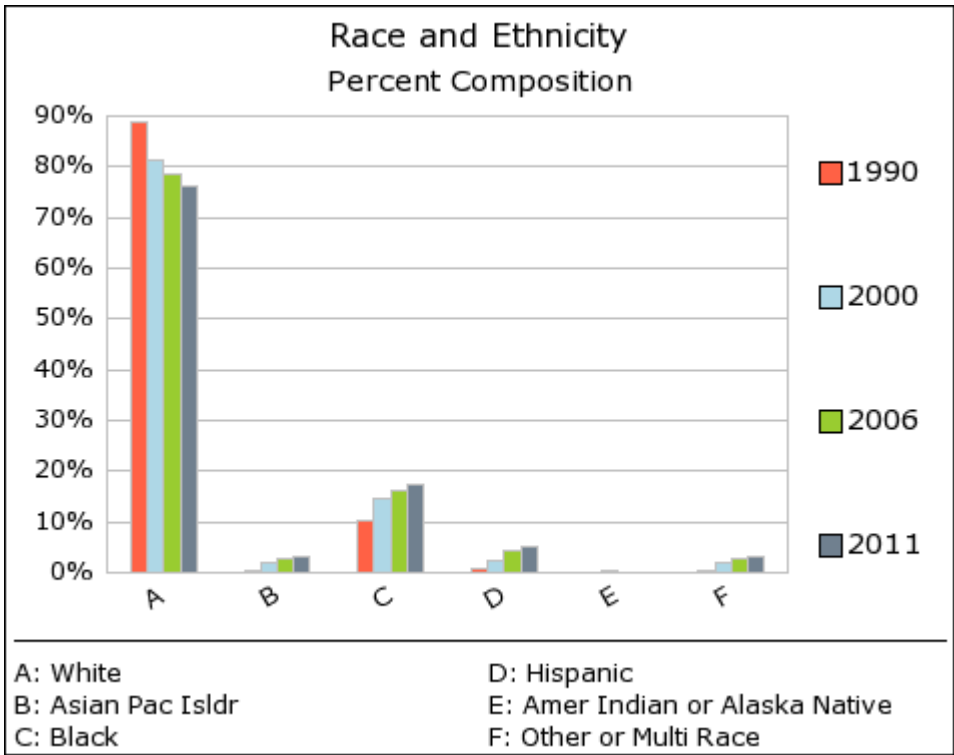


In 1990, the median age of the total population in the study area was **31.9**, and in 2000, it was **33.4**. The median age in 2006 is **33.1** and it is predicted to change in five years to **35.1** years. In 2006, females represented **50.4%** of the population with a median age of **33.8** and males represented **49.6%** of the population with a median age of **32.3** years. In 2006, the most prominent age group in this geography is **Age 35 to 44** years. The age group least represented in this geography is **75 +** years.

Population by Race/Ethnicity



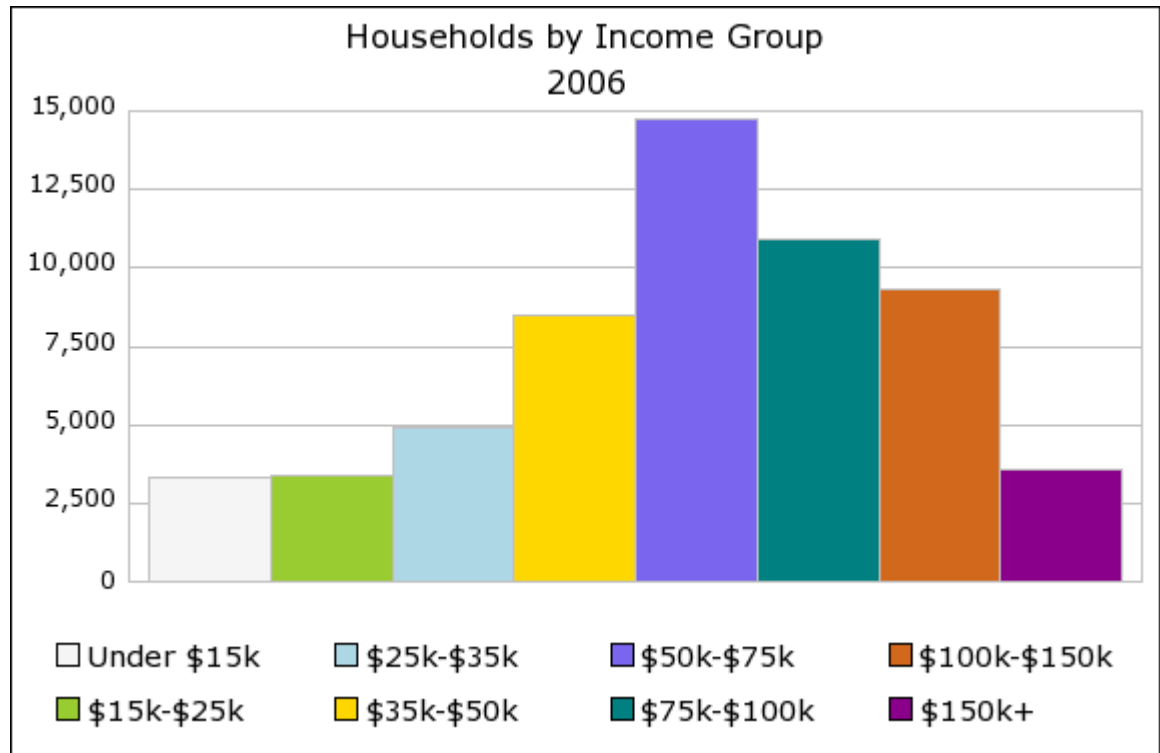
In 2006, the predominant race/ethnicity category in this study area is **White**. The race & ethnicity category least represented in this geography is **American Indian, Alaska Native**.
